Abertay University	Abertay International Scholarship £3,000 per academic year Applicable to new undergraduate and postgraduate taught students who have overseas fee status. No application is required. Applicants who receive an offer to study at Abertay will also be awarded the scholarship shortly after, including a link to accept the scholarship. The award is deducted from the tuition fees at the start of each academic year.	Abertay International Scholarship
	International Postgraduate Scholarship £3,000 Applicable to new postgraduate taught students who have overseas fee status. No application is required. Applicants who receive an offer to study at Abertay will also be awarded the scholarship shortly after, including a link to accept the scholarship. Brunel University	Fees for EU applicants For entry in 2022/3 academic year, eligible EU applicants will continue to have the same tuition fees as UK students to support EU students during this transition period. Cardiff University	Vice-Chancellor's EU Scholarship Awards of £5,000 for each year of study are available to EU, EEA and Swiss students paying international fees across a wide range of subject areas. Funding will be provided in the form of a tuition fee discount. Students who may not be eligible for the Vice-Chancellor's EU	Vice-Chancellor's EU Scholarship





Scholarship may instead be eligible for the <u>Vice-Chancellor's</u> <u>International Scholarship</u>.

Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship

Undergraduate awards

EU, EEA, and Swiss applicants, who are holding offers for selected undergraduate programmes, will automatically be considered for a Vice-Chancellor's EU Scholarship of £5,000. This will be applied as a tuition fee discount for each year of study.

You must submit your application through UCAS by 30 June 2022 and if you meet, or exceed, the conditions stated in your UCAS offer, or, if you are initially awarded an unconditional offer, you will automatically be granted the scholarship as a tuition fee discount.

This is subject to you meeting eligibility criteria as set out in the <u>terms</u> and <u>conditions</u>.

Postgraduate taught awards

EU, EEA and Swiss applicants who apply before 17 July 2022 and are holding offers for selected postgraduate programmes will automatically be considered for the Vice-Chancellor's EU Scholarship of £5,000. To be awarded a Vice-Chancellor's EU Scholarship you must meet, or exceed, the conditions of your offer. Applicants initially awarded unconditional offers will automatically be granted the scholarship, which will be in the form of a tuition fee discount.

This is subject to you meeting eligibility criteria as set out in the <u>terms</u> and <u>conditions</u>.

Postgraduate taught awards – eligible programmes

ESCP

ESCP have created a scholarship programme that encourages social diversity and values individual commitment.

Scholarships can cover 10% to 50% of tuition fees (excluding first-year registration fee) and are assigned based on different criteria such as merit, diversity and financial needs. They are renewable each year on condition of academic achievement, behaviour and involvement in the ESCP community.

CROUS scholarship holders: Students who are eligible for CROUS scholarships allocated by the French Ministry of Higher Education are eligible for an ESCP need based scholarship. The exemption percentage ranges from 10% to 50% depending on CROUS level.

Available to International and EU (non-UK) students starting a postgraduate taught Masters programme in any discipline for Academic Session 2022-23. Applicants holding offers will be automatically assessed for the scholarship based on academic merit. Applicants who are being considered for the scholarship will be notified within six weeks of receiving an offer of admission. There is no separate application form required. University of Kent	Special EU fee The University of Kent is offering EU students who start their programmes in the 2021/22 or 2022/23 academic year a special EU fee, which is 25% lower than their standard international fee. The special EU fee status will be guaranteed for the duration of your programme. There are also scholarships on offer.	EU applicant advice Kent scholarships
Newcastle University	Scholarships for EU students include automatic scholarships (Vice Chancellors EU Scholarships) where Newcastle discounts the international fee by up to 70% to bring the tuition fee in line with home student fees. No application necessary as they are automatically awarded once they make students a conditional offer. They are for UG and PG taught programmes, including MRes courses.	EU scholarship information
	Merit based scholarships (Vice Chancellors Excellence Scholarships) at both UG and PG level which students can apply for and these represent an additional £6,000 off the cost of tuition fees, on top of the automatic award mentioned above. Students must apply by May 2022.	

Nottingham Trent University	2 x 100% scholarships for students in the Business School (Vice Chancellors EU Business Excellence scholarships) – one at undergraduate level and one at postgraduate level. For students looking to study on a programme in the Business School. All scholarships are awarded for every year of study. NTU are offering the EU Excellence Scholarship for 2022 courses. This is a tuition fee reduction. For Undergraduate courses, this is a value of up to £6650, and for Postgraduate students up to 50% of tuition fee. 	permanent resident of EU country, and not hold settled or permanent resident status in UK. They can complete a simple online form to confirm they meet criteria.	
University of Sheffield	Sheffield offers scholarships for both Home & Overseas students at all levels, to attract and reward high-achieving applicants with excellent academic results and potential. These include the International Undergraduate & Postgraduate Merit Scholarships, IB Merit Scholarships, International Excellence Scholarships for Engineering & Computer Science, and PhD Scholarships.
